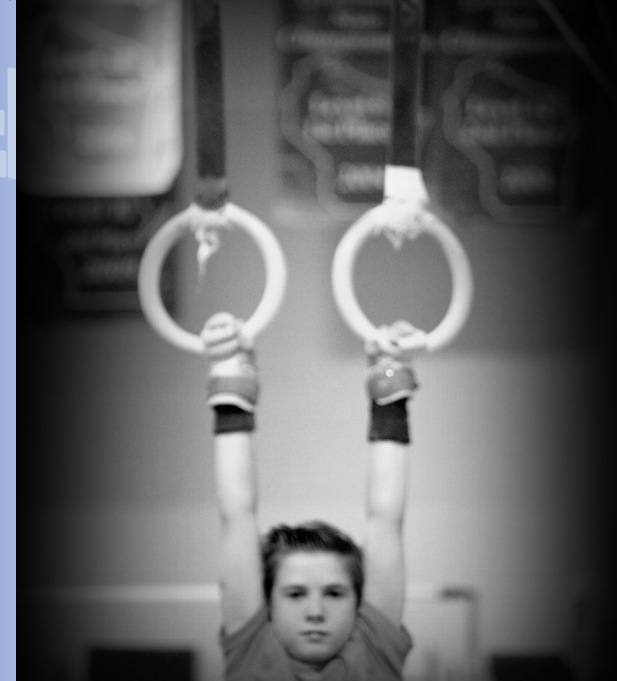

*WI PTA will send back a confirmation after receiving info for Chair.*

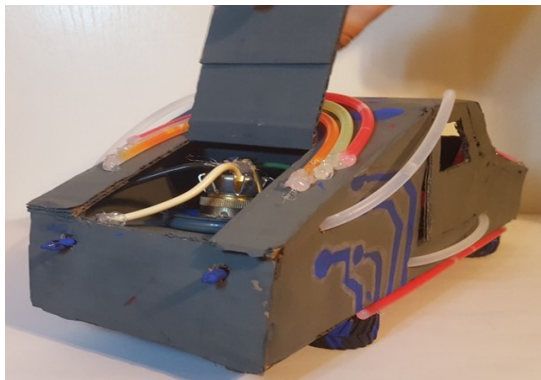
*Chair will receive IMPORTANT information on correct procedures for running the Reflection Program in your school.*

## The Arts and the National Standards

The arts—and the PTA Reflections Program, in particular—can be a valuable tool for building stronger partnerships in your school community. Consider ways to apply PTA’s National Standards for Family-School Partnerships to PTA Reflections activities.

### **Standard 1: Welcoming All Families into the School Community**

Families are active participants in the life of the school, and feel welcomed, valued, and connected to each other, to school staff, and to what students are learning and doing in class.

### **Standard 2: Communicating Effectively**

Families and school staff engage in regular, two-way, meaningful communication about student learning.

### **Standard 3: Supporting Student Success**

Families and school staff continuously collaborate to support students’ learning and healthy development both at home and at school, and have regular opportunities to strengthen their knowledge and skills to do so effectively.

### **Standard 4: Speaking Up for Every Child**

Families are empowered to be advocates for their own and other children, to ensure that students are treated fairly and have access to learning opportunities that will support their success.

### **Standard 5: Sharing Power**

Families and school staff are equal partners in decisions that affect children and families and together inform, influence, and create policies, practices, and programs.

### **Standard 6: Collaborating with Community**

Families and school staff, collaborate with community members to connect students, families, and staff to expanded learning opportunities, community services, and civic participation.

## Reflections...

In its more than 40-year history, the Reflections program has encouraged millions of students across the nation and in American schools overseas to explore their artistic talents. The program offers students the opportunity to create works of art for fun and recognition. Students in preschool through grade 12 are encouraged to submit works of art in six arts areas.

### **Reflections Theme - "The World Would Be A Better Place If..."**

Each year, the National PTA Reflections Program challenges students to create art inspired by a specific theme. Themes are selected from hundreds of ideas submitted by students in the PTA Reflections Program Theme Search Contest. Theme Search entry deadline is November 1, 2014. This contest is not online – a form will need to be printed and submitted to School Chair for fax or email to WI State PTA Office.

### **Mary Lou Anderson Reflections Arts Enhancement Grants**

The Mary Lou Anderson Grant Program is designed to implement student-centered programs focused on arts education. Grants of up to \$1,000 are given to PTAs through a competitive grant process to enhance arts programs.
